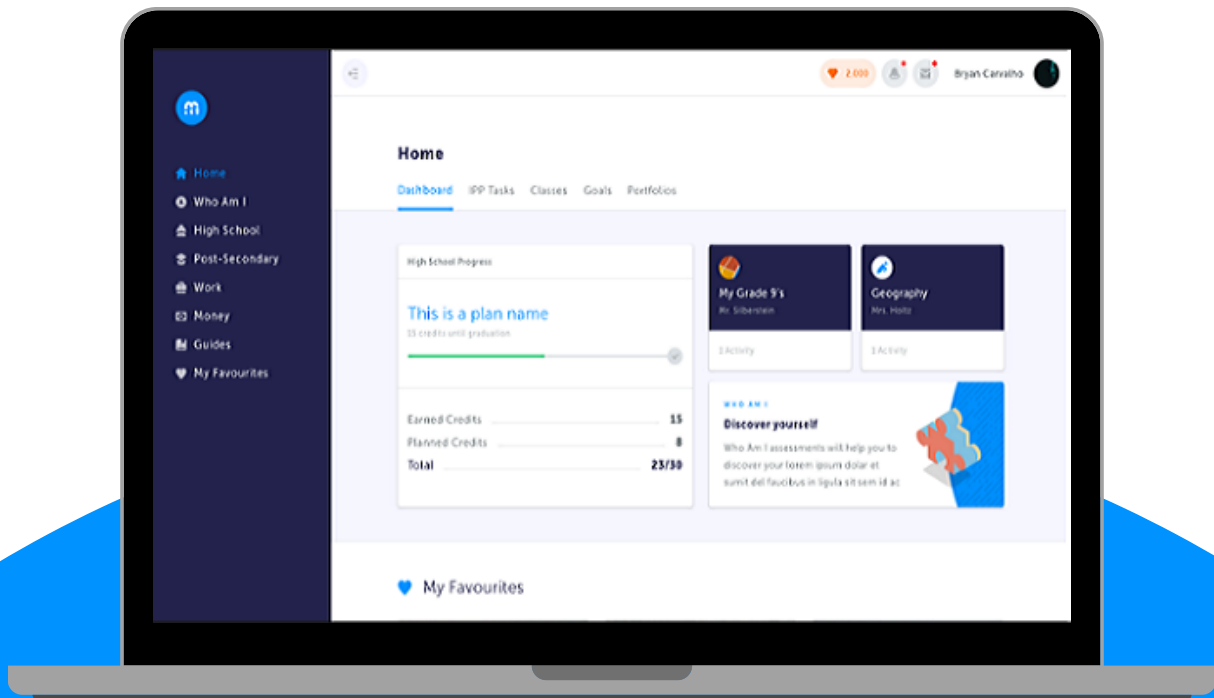

What is Education Planner?

Educational Planner is a comprehensive student-driven, career/life planning program with an interactive digital portfolio.

Education Planner will help students answer the following 4 questions:

- 1 Who am I?
- 2 What are my opportunities?
- 3 Who do I want to become?
- 4 What is my plan for achieving my goals?

Through the *myBlueprint Learner Workshop Series Pre-Recorded Videos*, learners will have the power to explore apprenticeships, post-secondary programs, occupations, and more! Help log them in to Education Planner to start exploring.

The Workshops

➤ Workshop #1: Who Am I Surveys

This workshop will help students answer question #1 on the previous page: "Who Am I?"

Note: Some classes might have already completed All the Who Am I surveys in recent past year, if this is the case, consider starting at workshop #2

➤ Workshop #2: Occupation Search and Portfolios

This workshop will help students answer questions #2 and #3 on the previous page: "What are my opportunities?" and "What do I want to become?"


➤ Workshop #3: High School Plan & Goal setting

This workshop will help students answer question #4 on the previous page: "What is my plan for achieving my goals?"

1 Before the showing Workshop videos

Workshop #1 Reflection Questions

What did you learn about yourself?

- Learning style** What is your learning style? How will knowing your learning style help you academically or personally? Select one of the study tips you have tried, and explain why it was beneficial.
- Personality** What is your personality type? What are two of the characteristics listed in your report? How can understanding your personality traits help you decide on a potential career?
- Interest** Do you agree with the description of your interest type? What are your primary and secondary interest traits? What are three of the occupation matches listed in the Match Results tab? Would you enjoy these careers? Why or why not?
- Knowledge** What are your top three subject areas? What topics do they include? What is your Career Cluster? What are some of the things someone in this career cluster would enjoy? Is it suited to your interests?
- Motivations** What are your top two motivation factors? How will understanding your top motivation factors help you achieve your goal? How will understanding your top motivation factors help you pick a career?
