HOPEFUL TRANSITIONS IMPLEMENTATION IDEAS

During the 2023-24 year, the Career Transition Coaches supported the participating pilot schools through facilitating a variety of experiential learning Career Connected Learning opportunities (for both students and staff), staff professional learning and fostered and further developed community partnerships and engagement. While all of the activities were well received, the student field trips and site visits, guest speaker presentations, and various career/expo fairs were particularly impactful in engaging the learners and staff alike. The table below provides a few real examples of just some of the types of activities that occurred.

Student Activities

- Meeting with students who indicated they had no career plans or needed assistance, based on survey data, and arranging for them to engage with an employment counsellor
