Before the Activity

- Take time to explore the <u>Student Guide</u> and adapt the activities/steps if needed.
- Share the <u>Student Guide</u> with your students
- Plan time in your schedule for the transition activities (at least two classes)
- Make sure your students have access to evidence of their learning (projects, evaluations etc.)

During the Activity

- Begin by playing the video titled "<u>Transition High</u> <u>School</u>" with your class.
- Ensure that all students have access to myBlueprint.
- Pause the video at designated points to facilitate discussions and allow for interaction.
- Provide ample time for students to complete each step outlined in the video.
- Support students throughout the process by offering guidance and providing additional examples as needed.
- Verify that students have evidence of their learning prepared and ready for review.

Post Activity

- Decide on the method for students to share their portfolios.
- Students can opt to share their portfolio by clicking on the "share" option and then sharing the generated link with you.
- Alternatively, utilize the "portfolio presentation feature" to organize students' presentations of their portfolios.
- Provide constructive feedback to students on their portfolios once they have been shared or presented.
